
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1. Key elements of the Climate Pact 2.0





National / regional stakeholders:

- Ministries et administrations
- Other stakeholders: nature parks, special interest groups, NGOs...



Background of the discussions on governance:

Experiences from the Climate Pact 1.0 as well as surveys among municipalities and climate advisors showing a necessity:

- 1. to see the Climate Pact become **more firmly anchored** in municipalities (organization, processes, routines...);
- 2. to promote a greater sense of responsibility at the **political decision making level**;
- 3. to facilitate key strategic decisions based on the introduction of **key indicators** and the setting of targets in accordance with the **national NECP goals**.



Integration of new criteria and obligations in the CP 2.0

- At the level of the contract, a set of basic obligations for municipalities was introduced (compliance is necessary for audits), examples:
 - The eea programme must be on the agenda of the municipal council at least once a year.
 - One political leader of the council of the mayor and aldermen is appointed as "climate alderman" by the municipality.
 - As part of the commitment in the Climate Pact, the municipality must set itself minimum objectives for the mandatory indicators.
- At the level of the Climate Pact catalogue, a variety of new quantitative and qualitative elements were integrated, which are not mandatory, but are being rewarded if implemented.



The "climate alderman"

- A member of the council of the mayor and aldermen is mandatorily appointed by the municipality as part of its commitment in the Climate Pact 2.0.
- The "climate alderman" has the task of accompanying and supporting the entire eea process in its planning and implementation phases.
- He supports the climate team as an active member and is an internal political ambassador of the Climate Pact within the municipality.

New qualitative and quantitative elements in the Climate Pact catalogue

- Introduction of new qualitative elements
 - Establishment of a climate team
 - Climate Pact check
 - Climate Pact conferences
 - Multipliers
- Introduction of new quantitative elements
 - Integration of mandatory and recommended quantitative indicators in the Climate Pact catalogue



Mandatory quantitative indicators of the Climate Pact (selection):

- Total heat consumption/energy reference area
- Total electrical consumption/energy reference area
- Installed photovoltaic capacity/potential
- Electrical share of municipal vehicle fleet
- Evolution of the implementation of the Climate Pact
- Number of energy advice/1000 inhabitants*year








Key implementation tools

- SIGI Dashboard In Climate Pact 2.0, centralised platform key indicators, which allows the definition of quantitative objectives and the recording of the annual progresses




